- Give and mark appropriate work
- Ensure that the learning environment is calm and purposeful

Learning Responsibilities:

The pupils are expected to:

- Arrive on time and attend regularly
- Respect others and the school environment
- Follow school rules and expectations of behaviour
- Have completed homework
- To do the very best they can



Parent/Carers Responsibilities

- Support the school's rules and behaviour policy by upholding the values of the school
- Support your child and school by sharing the same expectations at home of work and behaviour
- Ensure that the children arrive on time, having had a good night's sleep, eaten breakfast, are dressed appropriately and ready for work
- Attend teacher/parent meetings and help the child meet the targets set
- Support the homework policy by helping with reading, spelling and multiplication tables
- Ensure that children attend regularly unless they are ill
- Ensure that the school always has up to date telephone numbers in case of emergency
- Ensure that holidays are not taken in school term time
- Raise concerns by speaking to class teacher first
