The climate change march was held today and all classes have learnt about climate change. As a school, we do feel that this is an important cause and we know the children do too.

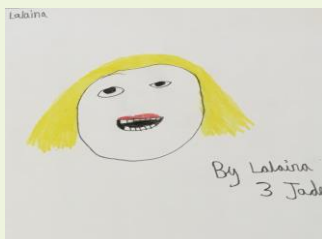
