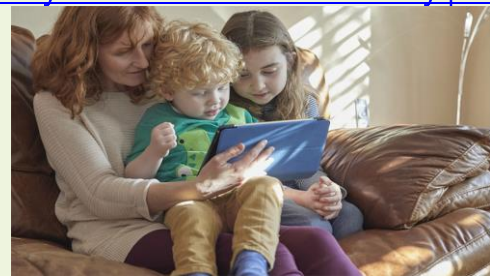
The winners of the best punctuality trophy are Y6 Ruby and Y5 Saffron with no late marks.
